Entry Requirements

 Possess a Bachelor's Degree in a related field (Honours) from the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) or any other recognised institution of higher learning, or possess other qualifications equivalent to a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) with professional qualifications or relevant experience recognised by the Senate of IIUM.

Specific Requirements

i. Applicants must possess a Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 or equivalent, as recognised by the IIUM Senate;

OR

ii. Applicants with a Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 but not meeting 2.50 may be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment;

OR

iii. Applicants without qualifications in a related field but possessing a Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) with a minimum CGPA of 2.00, as recognised by the IIUM Senate, and at least three (3) years of relevant working experience, may be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment;

OR

iv. Applicants without qualifications in a related field but possessing a Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) with a minimum CGPA of 2.00, as recognised by the IIUM Senate, and without relevant working experience, may be accepted subject to the completion of prerequisite courses;

OF

v. Other qualifications equivalent to a Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) as recognised by the Government of Malaysia.

Admission via APEL (A)

- Applicants must be Malaysian citizens with at least five (5) years of working experience at the time of application and possess a Diploma / A-Levels / STPM or other qualifications recognized as equivalent.
- Applicants must also have relevant working experience and/or prior experiential learning and pass the APEL (A) assessment for Master's level conducted by IIUM.


