## **Entry Requirement**

Entry requirement for Master in Finance Mixed Mode:

- i. A relevant Bachelor's degree with good grades from an accredited institution of higher learning or any other certificates recognised to be equivalent to a Bachelor's degree and with relevant professional experience.
- ii. In addition to the Kulliyyah requirements, an applicant must produce satisfactory proof of proficiency of English Language by:
  - The Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 550 or
  - The International English Language Testing Services (IELTS) with a score of 6.0 or
  - The IIUM-administered English Placement Test (EPT) with a minimum score 6.0.
- iii. The student must obtain a minimum B grade for all the 4 courses that were taken. Students failing to meet this requirement will have their mode of study changed to Coursework only.
