Entry Requirement

- 1) A relevant Bachelor's degree with good grades from an accredited institution of higher learning or any other certificates recognised to be equivalent to a Bachelor's degree and with relevant professional experience.
- 2) In addition to the Kulliyyah requirements, an applicant must produce satisfactory proof of proficiency in the English Language by:
 - The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 550 or
 - The International English Language Testing Services (IELTS) with a score of 6.0 or
 - The IIUM-administered English Placement Test (EPT) with a minimum score of 6.0.
