RESEARCH AND PUBLICATIONS IN ISLAMIC PERSPECTIVE (PART 4: PUBLICATIONS)

This article is the 4th part in the series of "Research and Publications in Islamic Perspective", while Part 1 was the introductory to this topic, Part 2 focused on experimental results of the research, and Part 3 discussed the presentation issues which is needed in any research, in this article (Part 4) we are going to discuss the publication of the results & finding of any research and the important of this matter from Islamic perspective.

A Muslim is required to know that documentation is very essential in Islam. "From the blessing of a statement is to refer it to its author/speaker" (The Book of the Messenger and Science, Yusuf al-Qaradawi).

This article is divided into a few parts, the first part (Part 1) focuses more on research activities, while this part going to discuss more on publication activities. One of the main purposes of publications is to share knowledge with others and transfer knowledge to the next generation, the Messenger of Allah says: "Convey (my teachings) to the people even if it were a single Ayah" (al-Bukhari).

The Prophet, peace be upon him, says: "The most beloved people to Allah are the people who benefit the others, and the most beloved deed to Allah is happiness you bring to your brother's heart, or relief him from stress or pay his debts or feed him in hunger, and he continued, for me to walk with my brother in a need is better for me than staying in an i'tikÉf in a masjid) and by masjid he meant Madinah". (Al-Tabarani: al-Mu'jam Al-AwsaÏ).

Citation is a very important activity of any research, the researcher is advised not to assign any data or results of others to himself, but rather he is advised to clearly cite, refer, and quote any statement of others, without any prejudice because doing so is their rights. Similarly, the researcher is required to be honest in his transmission of information; Allah Almighty promised them success in the Hereafter: "Those who faithfully observe their trusts and their covenants" (Al-Mu'minun: 8).

The information may not be compatible with his desire, or it may affect him and his status or position. Nevertheless, the researcher needs to be honest when he declares any information, whatever the circumstances may be.

Conclusion: Muslims must realise documentation matters. Published knowledge and knowledge transfer are its main goals. The researcher should not claim others' data or results, but rather cite, refer, and quote them without bias. Any researcher must be honest when providing information.
