EXPLORING JAPAN'S CUTTING-EDGE WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES THROUGH A STAFF MOBILITY PROGRAMME

We are pleased to present the outcomes of an exciting staff mobility programme that explored Japan's advanced waste management practices, with a particular focus on garbage incineration facilities. The purpose of this visit was to explore waste management practices in Japan, particularly its world-leading garbage incineration facilities, as part of the research activity supported by The Sumitomo Foundation (Grant no. 208401-029). Additionally, the programme aimed to foster networking and collaborative partnerships with the receiving institutions and explore potential avenues for future collaborations. The 10-day visit provided valuable insights into Japan's pioneering waste disposal technologies and laid the groundwork for potential future collaborations between IIUM and esteemed institutions in Japan.

The delegation, comprising esteemed researchers Dr. Ely Salwana Mat Surin (UKM), Dr. Zahidah Zulkifli (IIUM), and Dr. Norshita Mat Nayan (UKM), embarked on a journey to Tokyo, Japan, for this enlightening programme. The itinerary was thoughtfully designed to include a series of seminars, workshops, and meetings with experts from the University of Tokyo and representatives from Tokyo's waste management agencies.

A role model company's site/office for industrial waste management in Japan, Ishizaka Sangyo, was visited on 22nd July 2022. The delegation also had the opportunity to explore Tokyo's 23 wards management sites on 23rd July, gaining insights into municipal waste management. Tokyo Environmental Public Service office was another site visited on 24th July.

The Sumitomo Foundation, known for its support in the field of research, played a vital role in the programme, hosting the delegation on 25th and 26th July.

On 27th July, the delegation attended a research meeting at the University of Tokyo's Department of Chemical System Engineering. On the following day, they engaged in a research site visit and discussion at the University's Faculty of Computer Science. The programme concluded with a visit to the Faculty of Computer Science's Labs and Facilities on 29th July.

Throughout the visit, the delegation was warmly received and actively participated in knowledge exchange and discussions. The collaborative spirit showed by both IIUM researchers and their counterparts at the University of Tokyo and other institutions laid the foundation for potential future partnerships and research endeavours.

The delegation expressed their sincere gratitude to The Sumitomo Foundation for its financial support and to the University of Tokyo, Ishizaka Sangyo, Tokyo 23 wards management sites, and Tokyo Environmental Public Service office for their hospitality.

As the programme drew to a close, the researchers returned to Malaysia, carrying with them valuable insights and experience. This intercultural exchange has undoubtedly enriched among IIUM, UKM and Japan's academic community, fostering stronger ties and mutual learning in the field of waste management. We express our heartfelt gratitude to The Sumitomo Foundation, the University of Tokyo, and waste management agencies in Tokyo for their hospitality and support, which made this programme possible.




