Admission Requirements

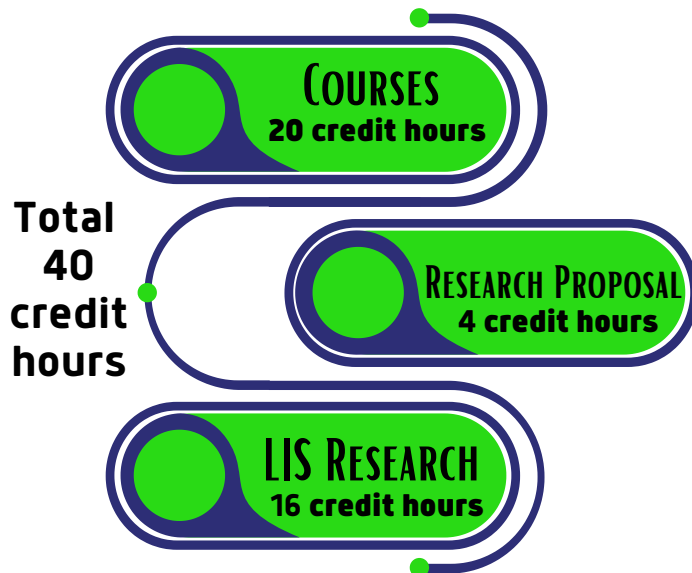
- A good bachelor's degree in any field from any academic institution recognized by the JPA with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 or its equivalent.
