Teaching critical, creative and caring thinking in schools is important because these skills are essential for survival in the twenty first century. In addition to these thinking skills, are collaborative and communication skills. That deep thinking or contemplation is critical is evident from the Qur'an and also from the tradition of the Prophet s.a.w. Teachers today not only impart knowledge, but they are designers, innovators, mentors, and many more. The Malaysian education system aspires to produce students who possess these soft skills. The process of learning is equally important as its product.

The Centre for Teaching Thinking in IIUM promotes these skills through its **Hikmah** (Wisdom) Pedagogy based on Lipman's Philosophy for Children Programme and the Socratic method. Using these as the framework, CTT developed the community of inquiry-based programme that incorporates common, central and contestable concepts and ethical values appropriate for any society.

OBJECTIVES

To enable students to:

- 1. Be curious about themselves and nature, and develop inquisitive minds as manifested through questions
- Be more critical, creative and ethical in their thoughts which help in solving problem and in making good judgements.
- Be more clear in presenting their views and in supporting them with sound arguments.
- 4. Improve their communication skills and develop better self-confidence.
- 5. Be more open-minded towards different ideas, cultures and religions.
- Deliberate over issues rationally through a Community of Inquiry that will foster personal and interpersonal skills.
- 7. Develop their imaginative, creative, intuitive and innovative abilities.
- 8. Find meaning in experience and apply them in their daily lives


