


PROGRAMME STRUCTURE



The trainees must successfully complete the programme including the three examinations before the conferment of M. Med (Psychiatry) degree.

Year 1 will comprise of one year posting in Basic Medical Sciences and Basic Psychiatry. The trainee isexpected to carry out coursework in additional to their clinical commitments.

Year 2 will comprise of four (4) specialty General postings of which Psychiatry, Rehabilitation andCommunity Psychiatry, Forensic Psychiatry, and Geriatric Psychiatry are mandatory. The trainee isexpected to carry out course-work in additional to their clinical commitments. The course work will include protocols, journal reviews. skills training, psychiatric research methodology training workshops and also maintain a log book.

EXAMINATIONS

- Part I examination of the M. Med (Psychiatry) programme will be conducted at end of Year 1.
- Part II examination will be conducted at end of Year 3.
- Part III Consultation Viva examination will be conducted at end of Year 4.

Year 3 will comprise of the training in General Psychiatry and specialty postings of Neurology, Childand Adolescence Psychiatry, and Addiction Psychiatry. The coursework will include case write ups, journal reviews, basic psychiatric skills training, research methodology training workshops and also maintain a log book.

Year 4 will comprise of the trainees functioning as Registrar in General Psychiatry. The trainee is expected to carry out coursework in addition to their clinical commitments. The clinical commitment will involve postings in General Psychiatry subspecialties namely Liaison Psychiatry and Administrative Psychiatry.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

MALAYSIAN APPLICANT

- Possesses a MBBS / MD degree or equivalent qualification from an institution recognised by the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC).
- Had undertaken at least one year of post-full registration clinical experience, preferably in a psychiatricrelatedfield, certified by the relevant authorities.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Favourable referees' reports
- Successfully completed the Entrance Evaluation by the Postgraduate Committee of the Department of Psychiatry



GENERAL REQUIREMENT

These will conform to the Postgraduate Regulations (Revised 2021) of the University.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANT

- Possesses a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery degree or equivalent from a university and is registrable under the Medical Practioner Act 1971 (Act No. 50) of Malaysia.
- Had undertaken at least three (3) years of post-registration clinical experience preferably in a psychiatric-related field certified by the relevant authorities.
- The applicant is required to undergo a six- month probation period in a psychiatric posting prior to acceptance into the programme.
- Show proof of financial ability to pursue their studies and live in Malaysia for the duration of study.
- A letter of financial guarantee/sponsorship or the most recent financial statement from applicant's bank is sufficient.
- Clear the medical check-up by the University's health authorities.
- Have international passports with at least two (2) years validity and meet all immigration procedures

PROGRAMME CONTENT

The Master of Medicine (Psychiatry) programme at IIUM (International Islamic University Malaysia) is a comprehensive postgraduate clinical training program designed to equip aspiring psychiatrists with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in the field of psychiatry. The programme spans a total duration of four years, which is organized into three distinct phases - Phase I (Year 1), Phase II (Year 2 and Year 3 - Rotational Subspecialty Posting), and Phase III (Consultation Psychiatry - Registrar in Training).
