## **Practical Information**

#### Visa

Students have to apply for a student visa. Please note that a tourist visa is not enough to stay in Indonesia for over one month.

### For full-time Student (4 years) and Exchange Program (6 months-1 year)

The International students who will study in UMY should obtain Study Permit and Student Visa. The process to acquire those documents are:

- UMY Proposes the Student Permit to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology
- UMY Proposes the Student Visa through the Directorate General of Immigration of Indonesia.

### For Internship, Student Exchange, and Short Course Program (Less than 6 months)

The process to apply Visa for program that less than 6 months is almost the same as full-time student. The students must have Permit and Student Visa, but it does not require the Limited Stay Permit (ITAS).

## Housing

The University provides free accommodation at the University Residence for all International Students. Student who takes Full Time Study with UMY scholarship, the dormitory will free for one year. The cost of off-campus accommodation varies, depending on the facilities available.

## **IMEI** Registration

You will need to register your phone IMEI in order to be activated with local sim card at the Airport Customs Office. You can ask the Office at Soekarno-Hatta Airport for more details. Not Registering your phones leads to inactivity of your phone data and no access of internet.

#### **Private Overseas Insurance**

All foreign students need to purchase their own overseas insurance, which includes health and accident coverage for the study period, in their home country before departure. UMY only provides clinic for small injuries
